Marcus' dozen plays include Winners and Losers, Ali & Ali and the aXes of Evil, King Arthur's Night, Jabber, The In-Between, A Line in the Sand, not to mention two East Van Pantos. They have been produced in multiple languages in more than twenty countries across North America, Europe and Asia. He is a recipient of the Siminovitch Prize for Theatre for his body of work as a playwright and mentor. Other awards: Germany's Ikarus Prize, Vancouver Mayor's Arts Award, Alcan Performing Arts Award, Chalmers' Canadian Play Award, Seattle Times Footlight award, Vancouver Critics' Innovation award (three times), Canada Council Staunch-Lynton Award and an Honorary Fellowship from Douglas College.
