Dr. Tsering Shakya is a widely published scholar on both historical and contemporary Tibet. His publications include *Seeing Lhasa: British Depictions of the Tibetan Capital 1936–1947*, edited with Clare Harris (2003) and *The Dragon in the Land of Snows: A History of Modern Tibet Since 1947* (1999), considered to be the first comprehensive account of Tibet's recent history. He is an Associate Professor in the Department of Asian Studies and School of Public Policy and Global Affairs, University of British Columbia (UBC) and serves on the Steering Committee of the UBC Himalaya Program.
